Fair Week Campground Rules

Fair week camping is only available for the entire week (Monday-Sunday) at a cost of \$150.

Sites for Exhibitors and the General Public will not be allocated or assigned until June 20th. If you are requesting a site in these categories you need not send payment you will be invoiced at that time. You may include a check or payment information if you choose and they will be not be charged until you are assigned a site. Otherwise payment will be due by July 15th or site will be reassigned.

Trailers may be placed on site on the Saturday before (exhibit drop-off day) but may not connect to electrical early.

Priority will be given to applicants in the following order: Fair Superintendents, Vendors, Livestock/Horse Exhibitors, and Still Exhibitors/General Public.

Campers must check-in at office upon arrival and obtain a permit. Camping permits must be displayed in an area on the camper that can be readily seen by the person inspecting the campgrounds as well as security personnel.

Camping is of a primitive type with electrical hook ups, no water or sewer; however water is available at the dumping station.

One RV or Trailer per campsite. An additional tent is allowable.

One (1) vehicle per campsite in campground area.
(Alternate parking is available)

All Hitches must be accessible (for emergency hookup).

No dumping of waste water. Please use dump station.

Dogs must be kept on leash and observe the quiet period. No walking of dogs within the camp area and all waste must be cleaned up by the person in charge of the animal.

No camp fires or open burning is permitted of any kind.

All camp sites must be kept clean and trash placed in the receptacles provided.

Those under 21 must be accompanied by a guardian while camping.

Quiet hours are from 11:00 PM to 6:00 AM)

Campsite must only be occupied by those registered.

All names of the camping party must be attached to the application. Emergency contact(s) and number(s) must also be listed.

Maximum of 8 people per campsite.

Campers must have 4ft open space on all sides.

Campers are required to carry their own insurance. Saginaw County Agricultural Society will not be held responsible for damages incurred while on the fairgrounds.
